- 2. On NEP Task force
  - Group went through the list of task force in different North Zone Provinces and found the list to be okay (except names of female representatives missing in some. Since emails/mob. - 4. Ways of empowering growing colleges:

However, since some colleges even after 15 years are still growing in certain areas (very young-in nascent stage, low student strength, slow growth due to locational disadvantages etc), we identified the following colleges:
  - St. Xavier's College, Umoid (Kphima Region); St. Xavier's College, Burdwan (Kolkata province); NB St. Xavier's College, (Darjeeling Province); St. Xavier's College of Management & Technology (Patna)
  - -Based on their capacity or lack of it the group proposed these following areas for empowering:
  - i) Helping/Mentoring in NAAC preparation (esp using IQAC of St. Xavier's Kolkata)
  - ii) FDPs for the faculties
  - iii)Setting up of Library (including upgradation, digitization etc)
  - iv)Human Resource Development (eg training and capacity building of non-teaching staff/librarians etc)
  - v) Sharing of resources such as, Library software, e-resources etc)
  - vi) Developing/creating Jesuit Spirituality/Ignatian Citizenship among the staff members (thereby orient them in Jesuit way of thinking/acting)
